- Meetings with local authorities and community leaders

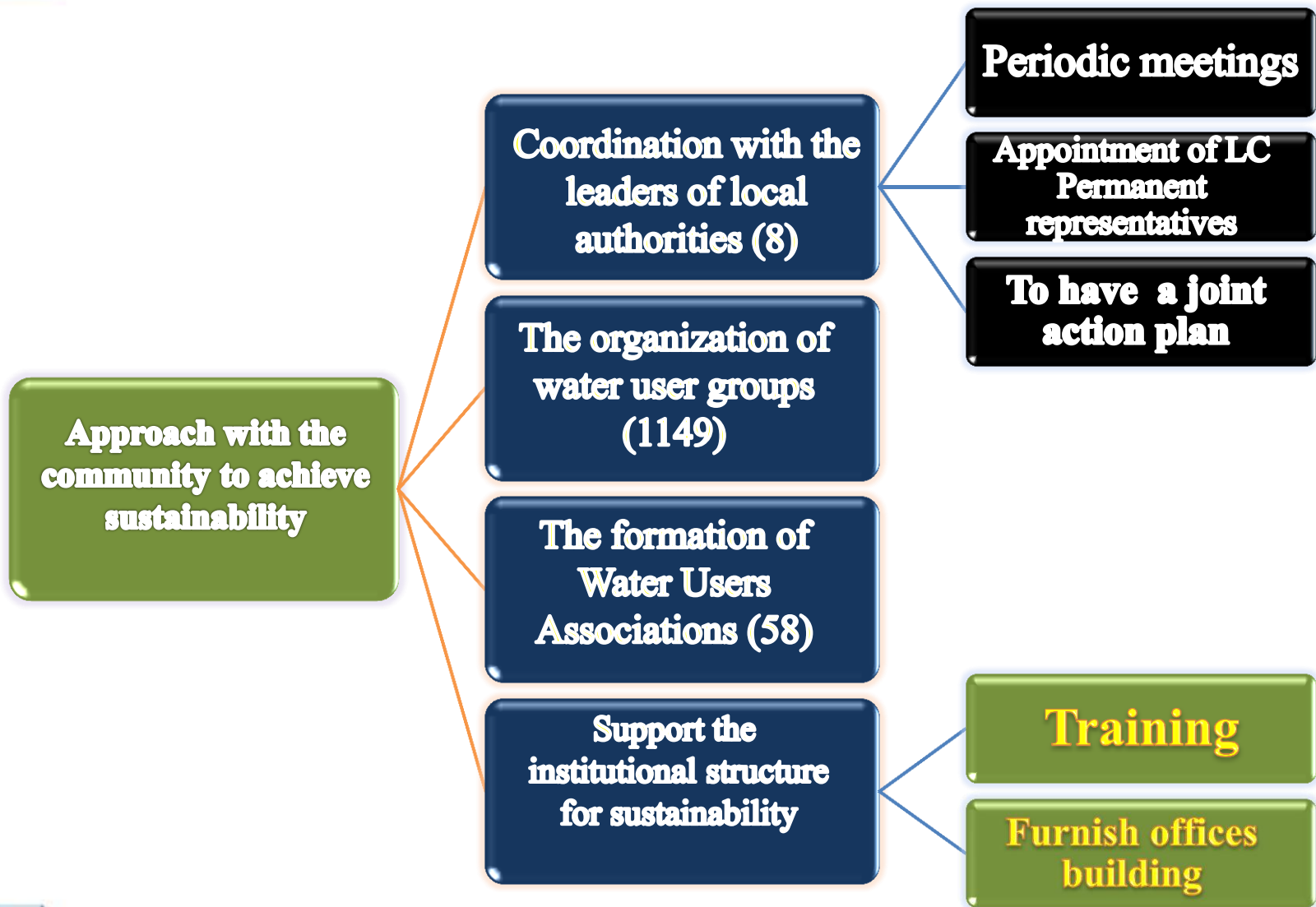
- Awareness campaigns for farmers

- Participate in the management of water resources

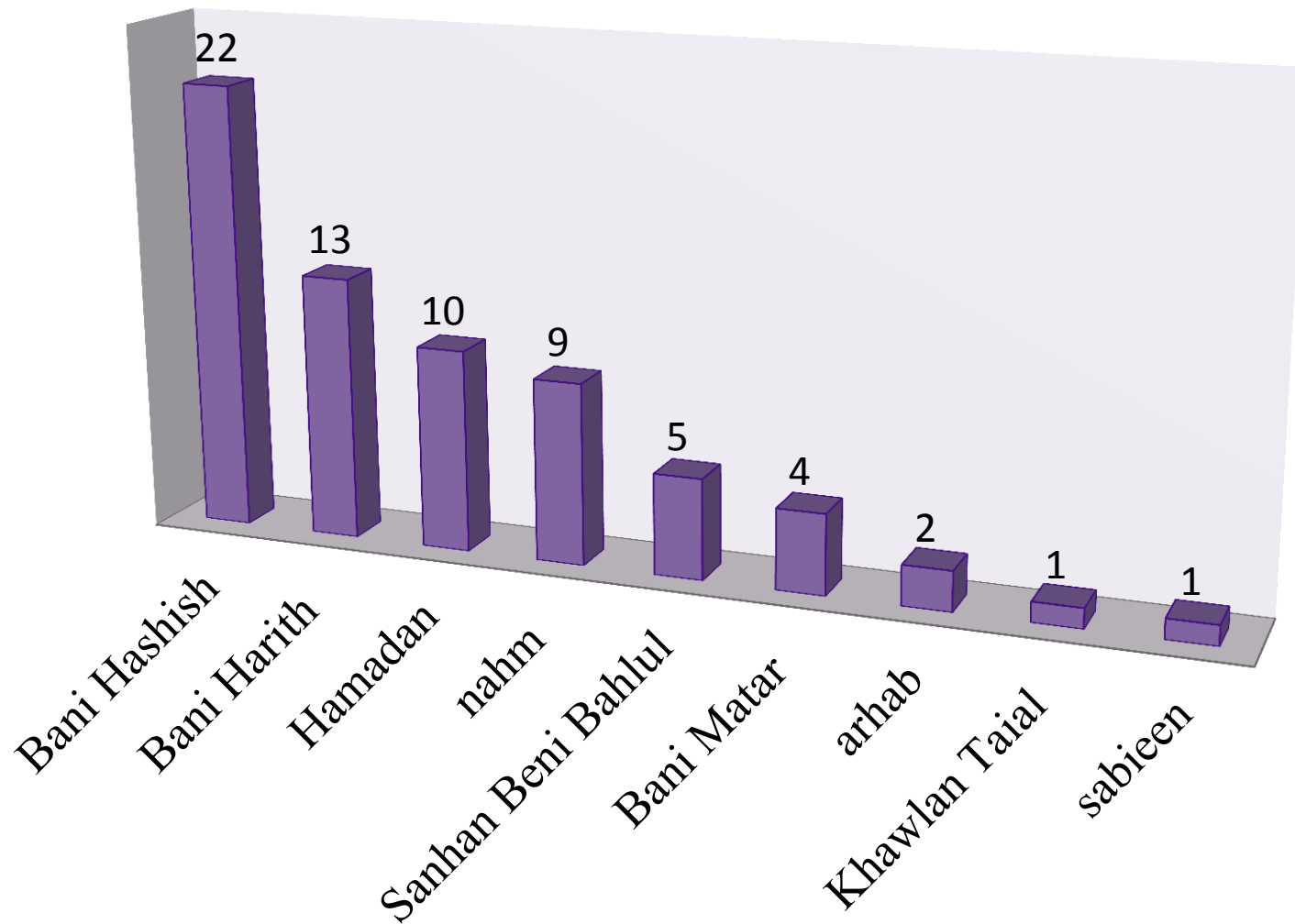
